How to find us ...

By train ...

The nearest train station is Norbiton which is served by South West Trains and receives regular services into and out of London Waterloo. Services to Norbiton run on the Kingston Loop and the Shepperton line.

By bus ...

Kingston Hospital is served by a number of bus routes. Bus stops can be found:-

From Kingston Hospital forecourt: K2 and K4

From Galsworthy Road: K3, 57, 213

From Coombe Road (A238): K2, K3, K4, K5

From Kingston Hill (A308): 57, 85, 213

Car parking ...

Please be aware that parking at the hospital site is limited and you should allow yourself plenty of time to find a parking space. At busy times, there may be queues for spaces. Alternatively, you could use the car park in Richmond Park, Kingston Gate which is a ten minute walk to the hospital. There is also unmetered free parking in nearby residential streets (a couple are named below – please refer to trusted online map websites for their locations) which are an approximate 10-20 minute walk from the hospital.

The hospital has pay and display car parks on site and the charging period for the car park is from 8:00am to 8:00pm, seven days a week. You will need to have the correct change for the pay and display machines (please note, there are no change machines on site). The current minimum fee is £1.80 (for the first hour) and £1.50 for each hour thereafter (up to five hours). Cars parked on site, not displaying a valid parking permit, or incorrectly parked, will be issued with a Parking Charge Notice. The Parking Charge Notice fee is £60, reduced to £40 if paid within seven days. The charge rises to £100 if not paid within 14 days.
